NEWSTRAWN.ORG is the City Hall website where you can go online to pay your bill, read minutes, read city ordinances or check out upcoming community events. You can also find forms such as new account applications, community building reser- vation and other licensing forms.

If paying your bill online, there is a 2.5 percent fee for credit cards and \$1.50 if pay- ing with your checking account. To avoid these fees charges by KanPay (not the City of New Strawn), you can pay in person or use the night drop box.
